## Build a Snowman

Go outside and build a snowman. Look around your house for eyes, nose, arms, and warm clothes for your snowman. Can you make five snowballs?



## Indoor Obstacle Course

Some ideas: crawl under or limbo between two chairs, pile some pillows to climb over, use a small object to pick up with toes, balance a small object in a spoon and move around the room.

## Indoor Snowball Fight

Using crumbled up paper or plastic wrap, have an indoor snowball fight.



## Indoor Picnic

Grab your favorite food and a comfy blanket and find a warm spot to have an indoor picnic.



## Write a Letter or Draw a Picture

Write a letter or draw a picture for a friend. Make sure to write your name so they know who it's from.



## Paper Snowflakes

Use scissors and paper to create snowflakes. Ask a grown up to help you fold and cut the paper. Hang it up in a special spot to decorate for winter.



## Sock Puppet Show

Look around for a sock, popsicle stick, or draw a picture and put on a puppet show. Have your family listen to your show!



## Ice Melting Experiment

Grab some ice or snow from outside. Using salt, sugar, or other spices, predict which would make the ice or snow melt.



## Puzzle/Board Game

Pick a favorite board game or puzzle to play with your family.

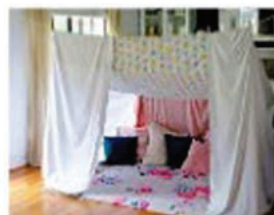


## Winter Story Acting
